1. HANDS ON TRAINING ON FRUITS AND VEGETABLE PROCESSING USING MOBILE PROCESSING VEHICLE FROM IIFPT

5. Pixel ratings of the latest mobile phones.

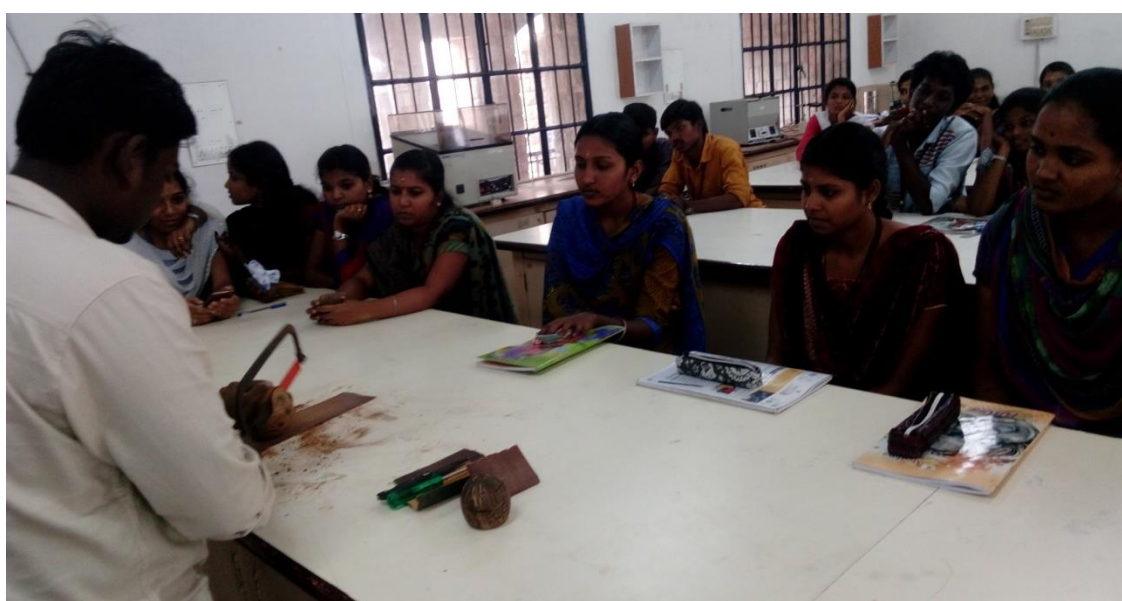
The student's learnt about the mechanism of transformer and its production use. He explained the repairing of electronic devices and gave suggestions to conserve the electric current usage.
